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Academy: Individual Learning Plan and Team Meetings

An individualized learning plan (ILP) is established for all our students. This plan helps guide our teachers and staff to meet the unique needs of the student.

Team Meetings:

Twice a year (October and May) a team meeting (parent conference) is held to discuss a student's progress.

Additionally, quarterly consult meetings are held that can support a student's needs.

Parents/guardians receive quarterly updates on their student's ILP and curriculum progress.

The quarterly reports come home in the following months: October, December, March and May.

Please see below the specifics for each of these meetings:

October Team Meeting (Parent Conference)

The team meeting in October consists of the parent, classroom teacher, administrator and therapists (as scheduling permits.) During this meeting we discuss the overall progress of the student in all areas.

May Team Meeting (Parent Conference)

The team meeting in May consists of the parent, classroom teacher, administrator and therapists (as scheduling permits.) During this meeting we discuss the overall school year, the upcoming school year, and student's placement, along with any other specific questions or concerns the parent/guardian(s) may have.

Consult Teams Meetings

Quarterly we hold a meeting that includes teachers, therapists, behavioral programming and support professionals (BPS), and administrators to discuss classroom needs and collaborate on how to best serve each student in the classroom.
